The conference is expected to involve domestic and foreign scientists in law, Post-Doctorate, other researchers, lectures from Universities, PhD students, representatives of state bodies, trade unions.

On the eve of the conference on **October 31st, 2019**, a series of open lectures by leading foreign scientists on labour law and social security law is planned.

At the opening of the conference on **November 1st, 2019**, the ceremony of awarding the winner and diploma winners of the *VI International Competition of scientific papers of students and undergraduates in labour law named after L. S. Tal – 2019* will be held.

Publications: Abstract requirements: **up to 5 page or 10,000 characters**, Times New Roman, 14 PP., Title in capital LETTERS (in the center), through the Line full name of the author, position, University (Institute), academic degree, title (in the center); through the line – the text of the annotation; indent 1,25.

Full scientific articles with the volume of 14,000-16,000 characters, issued according to the requirements posted on the Website of the Center for labour law (See: https://ctp.mitso.by/sites/default/files/Call-for-papers-LabourSocial_LawBelarus.pdf), can be accepted for publication in **the Volume 3(31) or №4(32) of the Scientific and practical journal «Labour and social law» for 2019.**

The materials as a special volume is expected to publish by the beginning of the conference. The organizing Committee reserves the right to edit the submitted abstracts or not to include them in this book.

Full scientific articles (no more than 20,000 characters) with high academic level issued according to the requirements posted on the Website of the Center for labour law (See: https://ctp.mitso.by/sites/default/files/Call-for-papers-LabourSocial_LawBelarus.pdf), can be accepted for publication in **the Volume 3 or №4 of the Scientific and practical journal «Labour and social law» for 2019.**
